To All Crestmont Homeowner Association Members and pending event guests,

As of Monday, September 20, 2021, the Crestmont Hall will follow the Government of Alberta's Restrictive Exemption Program Model.

Under this program, event access to the Crestmont Hall for will be limited to members or pending event guests who have one of the following:

- proof of vaccination
 - single dose accepted between September 20 and October 25 if received 2 weeks before time of service
 - double doses required after October 25
- documentation of a medical exemption
- proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of service (tests from AHS or Alberta Precision Laboratories not allowed)

We are pleased to be able to remain open to vaccinated members and guests and to continue offering access to the Crestmont Hall. Please be kind and respectful to our staff as we navigate these new procedures. To expedite access when visiting us, please make sure that you have your Crestmont resident card at all times and proof of vaccination, medical exemption or PCR/rapid test as outlined above.
